7. Registrations: **Registration for members of the Czech Judo Federation (ČSJu) is mandatory via the Central Evidence (CE) system from September 1, 2025, to September 3, 2025, until 11:00 PM.**
Unregistered competitors will not be allowed to participate! Unregistered competitors cannot compete.
Foreign competitors must register via their JudoManager Account by September 3, 2025, at 11:00 PM.
8. Payment: **The organizer covers the expenses of the delegated officials. Competitors participate at their own cost.**
9. Entry fee: **600,- Kč / 25€**
Payment of the entry fee must be made by **Thursday, September 4, 2025 (for details, see 16).**

B. Technical provisions:

10. Regulations: The competition will be conducted in accordance with the valid **judo rules**, the **Competition Rules of the Czech Judo Federation (SŘJ)**, the **RMS 2025**, and this event outline.

- **Men and women:** Born in **2007 or earlier**

(If the declared weight is not met, the competitor will not be allowed to start and the entry fee is forfeited)

Start of U16 competition: 9:00

Presentation and weigh-in for men and women: 11:30 – 12:00

(Weight tolerance of 1 kg)

Weigh-in without the possibility of changing the declared weight category

(If the declared weight is not met, the competitor will not be allowed to start and the entry fee is forfeited)

Start of men's and women's competition: Not before 12:30

Men OPEN category: Registration takes place during the men's competition; start time depends on the progress of the men's weight categories

17. Withdrawal of Competitors:

After the registration deadline in the Central Evidence system — **Wednesday, September 3, 2025, at 23:00** — it is no longer possible to withdraw a competitor.

Entry fees for competitors withdrawn after this deadline will not be refunded and will be forfeited to the organizer.

It is possible to **replace a registered competitor with another from the same club** no later than **Thursday, September 4, 2025, by 20:00**.

The total number of competitors from the club must remain unchanged.

Requests for competitor replacement in the start list must be sent **in writing** to navratil@czechjudo.cz.

19. Seeding:

The option to seed competitors for the draw is reserved for the coaches of the respective national teams.

Alternatively, the **top 4 present competitors** from the current **Ranking List** in each weight category may be seeded.

20. Coach's Challenge:

A coach's challenge system will be applied during the tournament – **[LINK HERE]**.

Only coaches with their own valid **Registration Card** from the central registry, **visibly worn on a lanyard around the neck**, will be allowed into the coach box or the area near the tatami.

Printing the card is the responsibility of the coach.

The organizer does **not** provide printing or distribution of these cards.

21. Coach Conduct and Attire:

Participants of the tournament are required to follow the **Code of Conduct for Coaches at ČSJu Competitions**. More information is available **[here]**.

22. Judogi (Uniforms):

Judogi must comply with the **currently valid judo rules** and approved **size specifications**.

- If a competitor enters a match wearing a judogi with a **"Backnumber"**, the name on the backnumber must match the **surname of the competitor**.
- If the names do not match, the competitor will be asked by the referee to change the judogi.
- If the competitor fails to do so within the given time, they will be **disqualified from the match** due to an **inappropriate competition uniform**.

However, the competitor is **not excluded from the entire competition** and may continue to compete.

- The **first-named competitor** must wear a **white judogi**.
- The **second-named competitor** may wear a **blue judogi**.
- Competitors on the **medal podium** must appear in a **white judogi and barefoot**.

24. Notes:

- The competition will take place on **8 tatami mats**.

They also commit to respecting and following all instructions given by the organizer or persons authorized by the organizer to manage the competition.
- **The Czech Judo Federation (ČSJu) or the event organizer is not obliged to compensate for any damage to health (injury) or property** of a participant who acts in violation of the above.
- **All activities and behavior at the competition venue that, by their nature, do not fall under participation in the competition are considered private matters.** The ČSJu and the organizer bear no responsibility for such actions or their possible consequences.

Team Leader:

- For this competition, the sending organization (club/team) must appoint a **team leader**.
- The team leader must be **at least 18 years old**.
- If necessary, the team leader must provide their name to the **head referee, sports director, or competition director**.
- If the team leader must leave the competition during the event, they must appoint a **new team leader**.
- The **rights and responsibilities** of the team leader are defined in **RMS Article 10.1.3**.
